KING'S FEZ stalked the leader, challenged in upper stretch, took the lead and drew off while under the whip for the win. DOUBLE WHAM lagged back, gained along the rail, lodged a bid inside, drifted out, bumped with BEHRACUDA late and bested that one for the place. BEHRACUDA lagged back, gained along the four path on the last turn, angled in some, was bumped late by DOUBLE WHAM, checked and then missed the place. VIBRANCE set the pace along the rail, was hooked in upper stretch and weakened. ADVENTUROUS PLAN saved ground, angled out on the last turn, lodged a bid and hung. BISTRO SOIREE was well placed up the backstretch, three path on the last turn and weakened. ROGUE'S MARCH five wide on the first turn, four path on the last turn and tired. SPEEDYSLASTCRUSADE was unhurried, saved ground on the last turn and tired. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the stretch run. Also a claim of foul was lodged by the rider of BEHRACUDA against DOUBLE WHAM for interference in deep stretch, resulted in the disqualification of DOUBLE WHAM from second to third.
