BENSON was unhurried, gained along the three path on the last turn, followed the winner into the lane and finished with good energy. PERRY LANE lagged far back, gained along the three path on the final bend and flattened out. PETEY BEDOUIN broke slow, saved ground up the backstretch, two path on the final bend and weakened. GAARA vied for the lead along the rail to the lane and tired. CAPTAIN NOAH vied for the lead along the two path on the turns and faded. FACE IN THE MIRROR four path on the turns and tired.
