LUCKY US never far back, gained along the three path on the last turn, quickly took command, opened up and then was under the whip for the win. GEE'S MONEY BOY broke slow, lagged far back along the rail, angled wide in the lane and closed fast. JESSIE TOWTRUCK was unhurried saving ground, eased out and hung. MILLENNIUM PRIDE tracked the leader, challenged the winner at the top of the lane, chased and weakened. SURPRISE STAR four wide on the first turn, three path on the last turn and weakened. DR. LIGNOM set the pace along the rail to midway on the last turn and faded. THEUNTRAINEDEYE tracked along the rail up the backstretch and tired. TWENTY TO LIFE fractious in the gate just before they opened, reared badly unseated and unseated the jockey. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning TWENTY TO LIFE at the start, resulted in declaring TWENTY TO LIFE a non-starter.
