JOURNEY TO NOWHERE broke on top, set the pace off the rail, turned back TOO TOUGH JAKE into the lane and was kept to the whip. CAYO HUESO tracked the leaders along the three path into the lane, asked, angled in some and finished well. PATRON SAINT was well placed along the rail, lodged a bid and weakened. TOO TOUGH JAKE broke sluggishly, rushed, tracked, challenged briefly at the top of the lane and faded. ELEGANT JETSETTER never far back, four path around the turn, angled out and weakened. AGAIN ELEVEN lagged back, four wide on the turn, entered the lane five wide and then finished wide. JUNGLE RAIN was unhurried, four wide on the turn, angled out and then failed to gain. PRESIDENT EATON broke sluggishly, saved ground and tired. PURE GRIT lagged back along the four path on the turn, angled wide and tired. ALMOST A FOOLS DAY two path around the turn and tired.
