Footnotes

PURA P T in tight into the first turn, checked, saved ground, eased out to the two path midway on the last turn, moved between foes into the lane, took command and under the whip outran THE OLE GEN to the wire. THE OLE GEN lagged back along the three path, gained four wide into the lane and rallied. SUSPICIOUS U never far back along the two path, three path midway on the last turn, four wide into the lane, responded and finished well. STAY ALITTLE WHILE lagged far back, saved ground on the turns and then passed faders. BUDDY RED tracked the leader, moved to challenge on the last turn, took the lead into lane, chased and weakened. ELPIDIO was well placed along the rail and tired. PARKINSON FIELD was well placed four wide up the backstretch, three around the last turn and tired. CROWN'S DOMINION set the pace and gave way.
