WATRALS SENOR was never far back, four path on the turn, gained into the lane, reached the pacesetters in midstretch and drove clear. WITCH WAYS WEST lagged back, five wide on the turn, angled wide in the lane and rallied. SENECA POINT lagged back while six wide on the turn, continued wide in the lane and rallied. CASH ME OUT was well placed along the four path, lodged a bid and finished with interest. POKER JOE was never far back, eased out in the lane, lacked room in midstretch and weakened. LYCENSE TO WIN lagged back along the three path, angled out in the lane and then lacked the late needed response. BEEBE'S FAMOOSE ducked in at the start, vied for the lead inside and gave way. THIRTEEN MIL vied for the lead from between foes and gave way. SWEET LUCY GRACE vied for the lead while three abreast and gave way.
