MIGHTY ANNIE R. broke well, set the pace along the three path and then widened some while under pressure for the win. DAZZLE ME DARLIN was well placed along the four path, three path on the turn, lodged a bid and finished second best. DOCSTAR stumbled at the start, unhurried along the four path, drifted in nearing the sixteenth pole bothering WATRALS DAHLIA and then finished well. CHATELIAN tracked the winner along the four path and weakened. QUIET ROSE was unhurried along the three path and then lacked a closing bid. EMPTOR forwardly placed while five wide on the turn and weakened. WATRALS DAHLIA lagged back along the rail, was bothered by DOCSTAR nearing the sixteenth pole and was forced to take up. SPECKLED SPICE was outrun. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the stretch run, resulted in the disqualification of DOCSTAR from third to seventh for bothering WATRALS DAHLIA at the sixteenth pole.
