WHO'S RALPH stalked along the two path and under the whip steadily gained on LOOPY DE LOOP for the win. LOOPY DE LOOP set the pace, widened in the lane and then couldn't last. BLACK MINOTAUR fractious, broke through the gate, reloaded, unhurried along the rail, steadied at the quarter pole and then rallied. GOOGLEIZED was unhurried, four path on the turns and then made a mild bid. CAMPANA was well placed along the rail and weakened. LOST SWORD was well placed, two path on the last turn and weakened. TAPITS MAIN MAN broke sluggishly and then saved ground. ADAM BOY two path on final bend and tired. BEHRACUDA three path on the turns and tired.
