BROCK N ROLL was well placed along the two path, launched a bid to collar the leader and drove clear. BAIT AND SWITCH forced the issue along the four path, dueled into the lane, could not handle the winner but held the place. CASTLE HARBOUR three path into the lane and rallied. MR. JOLSON gained along the rail on the turn and finished with interest. WESNIAK five wide on the turn and weakened. A. P. EDDIE gained along the rail on the turn and flattened out. PSYCHOTIC SUMMER broke sluggishly, three path on the turn and tired. BOB'S BIG HOPE broke slow, hit the gate spotting the field two lengths, four path on the turn and then failed to take part. BRASSY EVENT set the pace along the rail while pressed and gave way.
