CAYO HUESO broke well, set the pace while pressed along the two, angled to the three path into the lane, responded to the whip and held sway. PATRON SAINT forced the issue along the three path, four wide into the lane, chased to no avail but finished well. PRESIDENT EATON was unhurried six wide early, took the rail around the turn and finished with good energy along the fence. I'LL MAKE IT UP checked at the start, saved ground early, three wide on the turn, lodged a bid and hung. FELINEFELON was well placed four wide up the backstretch, three path on the turn and weakened. POINT CUMANA forced the issue early along the rail, angled wide in the lane and tired. ELEGANT JETSETTER five wide up the backstretch, four wide on the turn and then finished wide.
