SUNSHINE NUMBERS in hand off the rail, angled out to the four path on the turn, gained ground into the lane, collared the leaders nearing the eighth pole, drifted in under right handed pressure bothering EMBLEM BLUES and drove clear. EMBLEM BLUES vied for the lead along the three path, battled between foes, checked in midstretch when the winner drifted in and then finished well to earn the place. SIR KNIGHT SHOT vied for the lead off the rail, battled in the lane and faltered late. EMBRACE REALITY was unhurried along the rail, eased out in the lane, lodged a bid and then checked late. IRISH BLASS three path on the turn and then lacked a rally. TORTILLA SOUP lagged back and then entered the lane five wide. SNOOPSTER was well placed early, five wide on the turn and tired. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of EMBLEM BLUES against the winner for interference in midstretch, was not allowed.
