SARATOGA WARRIOR was well placed along the rail, eased out into the lane for room, quickly found the front and then widened proving clearly best. AHOY MATE lagged back, saved ground, angled out five wide into the lane and rallied wide. PLUS A FEVER lagged back, saved ground, angled out to the three path on the last turn, responded in the lane and rallied. BEACH HARBER MAN vied for the lead along the rail, off the rail on the last turn and weakened. TWINKLE IN HIS EYE was unhurried, gained four wide on the last turn and flattened out. GOLDEN WYATT gained along the rail leaving the backstretch, moved between foes at the top of the lane to challenge and then weakened. GARGANTUA forced the issue three across, battled nearing the quarter pole and tired. POINT CUMANA vied for the lead from between for a half mile and tired. J. R.'S REIGN three path on the turns and tired.
