PERFECT KRIS vied for the lead along the three path, between foes into the lane, shook loose some and then was all out to last. WINLOC'S HAIL MARY was well placed along the three path between foes on the bend, lacked room from the three-sixteenth to the eighth pole, eased out and finished with good energy. SELECTA vied for the lead off the rail, chased in the lane and then finished well. PETIT ETOILE was well placed along the four path, challenged outside foes at the top of the lane, chased in the drive and finished with interest. DARNITALLAGAIN lagged back, angled wide in the lane and then lacked a solid bid. J'S HEIDEE G. saved ground early and then angled out five wide on the turn. FIDDLERS CHANCE saved ground while well placed and then lacked room from the quarter pole to the eighth pole. GOLDEN ACE saved ground, was outrun.
