PURGE BIRD was unhurried, asked along the three path rounding the turn, responded, gained to take on the leader and drew off. CURRENT AQUASITION stalked the leader along the two path, gained on that one with success but could not handle the winner. U OUGHT TO KNOW sprinted to a lengthy lead along the rail, began to lose that long advantage and weakened. TIMMINS lagged back along the two path, eased out and made a late bid. THE BUTLER DID IT was unhurried along the three path and finished with interest. KALL ME SIG saved ground and tired. CRACK EN TOO two path on the bend and then failed to gain. SEABET tracked inside early and tried. GEE'S MONEY BOY six wide up the backstretch, four wide on the turn and finished wide.
