Footnotes

SANTA FE BABE set the pace off the rail, widened on the last turn and under mild pressure proved best. SCENE N HEARD lagged back, gained six wide on the last turn and rallied to clearly best the rest. SO GRACIOUS lagged back, gained along the three path on the last turn and then flattened out. OLD HUSSY was unhurried early, gained along the three path leaving the backstretch, bothered OLD HUSSY midway on the last turn and then flattened out. HIGHWAYTOHAPPINESS was well placed up the backstretch, four path on the last turn and weakened. BEFORTHWESTWASWON six wide on the first turn, five wide on the last turn and weakened. OXFORD GIRL broke sluggishly, was outrun. KNOWNOWTHISISTRUE tracked along the three path and tired. CASUAL HINT was well placed along the rail, bothered by OLD HUSSY midway on the turn, took up sharply and then dropped back. A claim of was lodged by the rider of CASUAL HINT against OLD HUSSY for interference midway on the last turn, resulted in the disqualification of OLD HUSSY from fourth to ninth.
