NUMEROUS ANSWERS set the pace along the rail, dueled on the last turn, responded when asked leaving the eighth pole and then drove clear. NINE TU TU'S six wide on the first turn, tracked the winner along the three path, moved to challenged after a half mile, dueled on the last turn, battled into the lane and then was no match. HELLO JUDY was unhurried along the rail, angled out on the last turn, lodged a bid outside in the lane and finished with interest. FLEETENGLY lagged back along the rail and then failed to menace. BRIEFCASE GIRL was well placed along the three path for a half mile and then tired. QUEEN JEAN seven wide on the first turn, was well placed along the five path up the backstretch and then was done on the final turn.
