WITH A CAPE broke quickest of all, set the pace along the rail and then widened late while kept to pressure. TAKE DOWN TWO was well placed along the two path on the turns, eased out, lodged a bid to no avail but held the place. BRIDGE TO NOWHERE never far back, three path on the turns, responded and finished well. ONESHOTAWAY was well placed up the backstretch, four path on then last turn and then failed to close. SMALL TOWN saved ground on the turns and tired. NORTHERN BANDIT tracked the winner along the three turns and tired.
