RULE SEVENTY SIX quickly established the lead, showed the way off the rail and under the whip proved clearly best. SMOKIN WARRIOR stalked the winner along the three path, lodged a bid to no avail but finished second best. HUNTING MONEY never far back, three path on the turn and then had enough to earn a share. WILD HERO checked from between foes at the five-eighths pole, saved ground on the turn and hung. CLASS CLOWN was well placed along the three path to the stretch and weakened. HAIDUK three path on the bend and tired.
