TWO CATS set the pace along the rail on the turns, was hooked in midstretch, battled to the line and held on for the win. BORACAY WONDER never far back, saved ground on the final turn, eased out, challenged between and then matched strides to the line to just miss. FIRE IN HIS EYES was unhurried, two path on the turns, eased out and finished well. SHORT TIME AFFAIR taken back at the start, gained along the four path on the last turn, entered the lane five wide and flattened out. NEVERABETTERCITY checked leaving the seven-eighths pole, tracked along the three path on the last turn, challenged and then weakened. HE AINT EASY unhurried, entered the stretch four wide and hung. AMERICANISM never far back saving ground and then weakened leaving the eighth pole. MAX CAM broke slow and then saved ground. EASY SPUR lagged back, three path on the turns and then was never in it. STELLAR AMBITION stalked the winner along the two path and tired. THAT'LL DO tracked outside up the backstretch and tired.
