BUNNY SLOPE vied for the lead while three abreast along the four path, shook loose nearing the quarter pole, responded when challenged some in midstretch and under the whip proved best. JEB'S SONG was never far back along the three path, angled out into the lane, loomed a threat but was no match. SEA ECHO ducked out at the start, well placed along the four path on the turn, lodged a bid in the lane and finished with interest. BUBBLY BROOKE lagged back along the rail, was not a threat. THREE DAY BULLET vied for the lead from between horses early, chased into the lane and gave way. THUNDER JAM vied for the lead along the rail and gave way.
