### Footnotes

THE GRIEVANCE MAN was well placed along the rail, took the lead from the inside and was under the whip for the win. TINIAN ISLAND broke on top, set the pace off the rail, was hooked and then finished well. WHEELER DEALER well placed along the two path and finished with interest. GREAT RECESSION was unhurried, saved ground, eased out, gained, appeared to jump a shadow at the sixteenth pole, bobbled, checked while losing all chance. MCGEE'S MIRICLE hesitated badly at the start losing all chance. NO TIME FOR LOVE was well placed along the three path, lodged a bid outside and then checked late when startled by GREAT RECESSION. CURIOUS MAC broke slow spotting the field three lengths and then saved ground. SOLIDIFY broke slow spotting the field a length, three path on the turn and tired. HE'S A BUSTER four path on the turn and tired. A Stewards inquiry was posted concerning the start and GREAT RECESSION jumping the shadow at the sixteenth pole, resulted in no change.
