BROOKLYN BOUND lagged back saving ground, launched a bid inside into the lane, collared the leaders along the fence and under the whip outran DANCING ROBBINS to the wire. DANCING ROBBINS was unhurried, two path on the first turn, gained along the rail on the last turn, angled out, challenged four across in midstretch, battled and just missed. WILL RUN FOR GOLD vied for the lead along the two path on the turns, battled between in midstretch and then weakened late. BILL SENIOR checked hard early, vied for the lead along the rail and weakened in the final eighth. MY SON SQUALL was well placed along the three path on the turns, gained into the lane and flattened out. GREAT BEAR was well placed up the backstretch, two path on the last turn and weakened.
