YONNI broke well, set the pace off the rail and under the whip held sway. KATLYN ANN was well placed tracking along the three path into the lane, gained some to no avail but finished well. GENUINE OFFER was unhurried, entered the lane four wide and made a late bid. PITCHING PENNIES was unhurried saving ground, eased out and finished with interest. PRINCESS NATALIE lagged back along the two path and then lacked a solid bid. DEPUTY MAJOR was well placed along the four path into the lane and tired. HOLY SPICE tracked early, saved ground on the turn and tired. YELLOW BRASS broke sluggishly, four path on the turn, was outrun. ONE FOR GRANDPA saved ground and tired.
