BLUESPOWERHOUSE in hand along the rail, slipped inside when able, quickly took command, opened up some in midstretch and under the whip proved best. OSTIN'S MIRACLE lagged back, saved ground, continued inside and finished with good energy. PERSONAL SPENDER broke slow, five wide on the turn, continued wide in the lane and rallied. SUNDAY DREAMER broke well, set the pace off the rail, was hooked, battled some and weakened. ROCKINANRACIN was unhurried along the rail, two path on the turn and then failed to gain. LOVIN THE BLUES five wide up the backstretch, five wide on the turn and then finished wide. FAIRWAY TOM was well placed four wide on the turn, appeared in tight nearing the quarter pole, checked, bobbed and then could not get back on track. YOU WILLGO BROKE lagged back, four wide up the backstretch, three path on the turn, angled wide and tired. D' FIGHTER stalked, challenged three across at the top of the lane and faded.
