INDIAN WAR DANCE gained along the four path, lodged a bid outside, took charge and then drifted out through the final sixteenths while clear for the win. MR. JOYSTICK tracked the leader, two path into the lane and finished well to earn the place. SAME DAY PLEASURE was well placed, two path on the turn, eased out and finished with interest. ITS GOODTOBEKING broke well, showed the way and weakened. WESTERN DEED saved ground, altered out abruptly to the four path into the lane and hung. WHO'S LIVIN BETTOR forced the issue early, saved ground and tired. TWO GENDARMES two path on the turn, was not a factor. EAST END BOY three path on the turn and weakened. EL HANNAN'S STORM four path on the turn, was not a threat. SAY KARAKORM SANDY angled out five wide into the lane and then failed to respond. LEXINGTON CONCORD four path into the lane and tired. OUT FOR FAME saved ground, was outrun.
