AUDIES CHAMP in hand along the two path up the backstretch, dropped back into the last turn, lacked room from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, found an opening, asked and rallied for the win. SNAP CALL was unhurried along the three path, between three deep on the last turn, responded in the lane, took the lead briefly and then just missed. ROCKY WORLD lagged back four wide, gained five wide on the last turn, angled wide and rallied. LEMON PEEL vied for the lead three across after a half mile to the quarter pole, battled between in the lane and then faltered late. MESSORIO was well placed four wide up the backstretch, four wide on the last turn, moved to challenged in midstretch and then could not sustain the bid. VICARIOUSLYUTOPIAN vied for the lead after a half mile, saved on the last turn and weakened. GYPSY WARRIOR forced the issue from between foes after a half mile to the midway around the last turn and then began to dropped back. AOJA vied for the lead from between early, saved ground on the last turn and tired.
