FOUR NINE WHISKEY tracked along the four path, three path on the turn, dueled at the top of the lane, shook free and then was whipped to the wire for the win. BROOKE HALEY was unhurried, gained along the rail on the turn, angled out, chased and finished with good energy. MANA'S MAGIC was unhurried along the rail, lodged a bid and finished well. BLACK LIGHT DANCER five wide on the turn and then continued wide in the lane. SPLENDID VIRTUE was well placed along the four path, angled wide in the lane and weakened. BE LONG GONE tracked along the three path early and tired. PRIMARY MOTIVE set the pace off the rail to the top of the lane and gave way. STORMIN INCA was done early.
