Footnotes

MONEYINYOUR POCKET tracked along the three path up the backstretch, took over into the lane and then widened under the whip. JET SET CAT assumed the lead, set the pace off the rail, was hooked and then drifted out through stretch while clear for the place. GREAT BEAR was unhurried, saved ground on the turn, responded and closed well. PARRELO was unhurried four wide into the backstretch, five wide on the last turn and then made a mild bid. MONSTER ME lagged back along the rail, three path on the last turn and made a mild gain. DOUBLE WHAM broke sluggishly, well placed up the backstretch, three path on the last turn while gaining some and then flattened out. BLUFF ROAD tracked up the backstretch, dropped back along the two path into the lane and tired. ROCKSTAR ONE O ONE close up after a half mile, dropped back on the last turn and was eased.
