GOOGLEIZED was well placed saving ground, eased out midway on the last turn, quickly took command and then outran VLAST to the line. VLAST lagged back, four path on the turns, angled out and rallied. BLACK MINOTAUR was well placed, gained along the two path on the last turn, challenged for the lead, took the advantage into the lane and then could not sustain the bid. J. R.'S REIGN ducked out at the start, well placed in hand, asked along the three path on the final turn and weakened. CAMPANA gained along the three path on the last turn and flattened out. BEHRACUDA vied for the lead along the rail, kicked clear after a half mile, was hooked and faded. REAL GENTLEMAN lagged back along the rail, angled out in the lane and finished extremely wide. BROLIO vied for the lead, tracked, dropped out of it and then was being eased into the lane.
