### Footnotes

KELLSTER moved to challenge from between foes after a half mile, dueled on the last turn, kicked well clear in midstretch and then was kept to the whip. NEW YORK MIRACLE never far back along the rail, gained on the last turn, eased out and finished well. EMOTIONLTRAINWRECK checked at the start, moved to challenge four across after a half mile, dueled the winner around the last turn to no avail and weakened. LOVE TO WIN was unhurried, gained some two off the rail on the last turn and flattened out. SHESA BARBI DOLL was well placed early, dropped back after a half mile, saved ground on the last turn and then failed to fire. CAT A BIT lagged along the rail, eased out and passed faders. NEXT TOP MODEL ducked out at the start, vied lead between three deep after a half mile, three path on the last turn and tired. PRIVATE MERGER six wide up the backstretch, three path on the last turn and tired. SAY SASSY LASSIE was unhurried, far back along the three path on the last turn and tired. KWAZY KWISP set the pace early and gave way.
