HELLO JUDY was unhurried along the four path, gained ground on the last turn, angled out some in the lane and rallied. IFEELMISTY tracked the winner along the four path, lodged a bid in the lane and finished well. BRIEFCASE GIRL lagged back along the rail, lodged a bid inside and passed faders. FLEETENGLY lagged back and then failed to menace. QUEEN JEAN was well placed along the three path to the lane and tired. SURGEON saved ground, was close up for a half mile and then tired.
