ROMAN A CLEF stalked outside up the backstretch, two path around the turn, moved to challenge nearing the sixteenths pole and under the whip proved best. YUKON GOLD RUSH vied for the lead along the rail early, took charge on the bend, was hooked and finished well to best the rest. EARLY RESPONSE never far back along the rail, angled out and hung. CASH ME OUT was unhurried along the rail on the turn and the lacked a rally. GRANDDAMSLAM was unhurried two from the rail on the corner, angled out and weakened. DANCING ROBBINS lagged back four wide on the turn, angled wide and then failed to take part. DADE CITY was well placed along the three path on the turn, four wide into the lane and tired.
