HOOKED ON MONEY never far back, four path on the turn, angled wide and finished well. SISTER'S SPEED was well placed along the rail, chased in the lane and then missed the place. WARM COUNTRY lagged back, three path on the turn, angled wide for the drive and closed well. C. T. PHONE HOME tracked along the four path into the lane and weakened. YOU'LL REMEMBER ME was unhurried along the four path and then finished wide. LE CHESNAY saved ground and tired. TRI TO BEA EARLY forced the issue briefly and gave way.
