WHO'S ZAT GIRL forced the issue up the backstretch, took command along the two path on the turn and then widened while under the whip. CATILLAC CUTIE was well placed along the two path, angled out, chased to no avail but finished well. THUNDER ROARING saved ground unhurried, three path into the lane, angled out and closed well. HORNET'S NEST broke sluggishly, two path up the backstretch, two path on the turn and then weakened inside. ANCIENT DEVIL was well placed along the three path, four wide into the lane and faded. DONTRAINONMYPARADE was well placed early along the rail, continued to save ground on the bend and tired. ORIENTAL GOLD checked at the start, lagged back three form the rail on the turn and tired. MINIVAN ducked out at the start, vied for the lead along the rail with the winner, chased that one on the turn and gave way.
