MOLLIE'S PRIZE sprinted clear, showed the way along the rail and then widened to a lengthy tally while proving clearly best. EMOTIONLTRAINWRECK was unhurried early, gained two off the rail on the last turn, chased to no avail but finished well. NEW YORK MIRACLE was unhurried off the rail, took the fence on the last turn while gaining some and then flattened out. RAINBOW EXPRESS was well placed along the three path heading up the backstretch, two path into the lane and weakened. MISS BRASS BONANZA stalked the winner up the backstretch two from the rail and then dropped back along the three path into the lane. R GIRL PAYNES lagged back, saved ground throughout and tired.
