JUDGE JOHN B. lagged back along the three path, gained, checked at the quarter pole, responded when clear and rallied for the win. SHACHNER vied for the lead along the four path, shook loose in the lane, was hooked late and then lasted for the place. CASH ME OUT was unhurried five wide on the turn, angled out and rallied. HE DID IT ducked in at the start bothering PHILLY FRENZY and EL HURACAN, lagged back along the three path, checked midway on the turn and then rallied. PHILLY FRENZY checked at the start, six wide on the turn and then lacked a rally. SENECA POINT three path on the turn and weakened. SUCCESSFUL SECRETS was well placed five wide on the turn and tired. EL HURACAN checked at the start, saved ground and tired. TWO WEST vied for the lead along the three path and gave way.
