BUCKY was unhurried along the rail, responded inside and finished with good energy. GREENWOOD BOY stalked the winner, three path on the last turn, responded and finished well. DIAMOND SHOWCASE gained four wide on the last turn and flattened out. INNTHWEST lagged back, four wide on the last turn and then failed to gain. MIKE'S INSTINCT was well placed along the rail to the last turn and weakened. ANDRETTI tracked up the backstretch, three path on the final turn and tired.
