Footnotes

CAYO HUESO broke on top, vied for the lead along the three path up the backstretch, took charge along the two path rounding the bend and under the whip never gave up any ground. BRENDAN'S WARRIOR was well placed along the four path around the turn, chased outside in the lane and finished well to earn the place. CAT PHONE broke sluggishly, unhurried saving ground, took the two path midway on the turn, angled out for room and closed fast. SURFING IAN vied for the lead early, tracked the winner inside around the turn and weakened in the late stages. DEVONSHIRE never far back along the two path, in striking distance into the lane and then failed to gain. PONTE VECCHIO never far back three from the rail, four wide into the lane and then failed to make-up any ground. HI HO SILVERMAN was well placed four from the fence up the backstretch, three path on the turn and weakened. PERRY LANE four wide up the backstretch while well back and then was outrun along the three path into the lane. PLEASE IMPRESS was well placed along the rail and tired. BIG FEARLESS saved ground while showing little.
