LEMON PEEL contested the lead along the rail, eased out some in the lane, battled to the line with RAECINJASIN and under the whip held that one at bay. RAECINJASIN contested the lead along the two path with the winner, battled to the line with that one and finished gamely to just miss. MOM PROOF was well placed along the two path up the backstretch, continued on that path on the final turn, took the fence in the drive, gained some and finished well. BRASS NOTE was well placed four wide up the backstretch, three path on the final turn, angled out some and finished with interest. AHOY MATE five wide up the backstretch, two path on the final turn, angled out and then lacked a rally. STAY ALITTLE WHILE lagged back while four from the rail up the backstretch, four wide into the lane and then failed to gain.
