U OUGHT TO KNOW broke on top, set the pace removed from the rail, was hooked in midstretch, battled and under the whip turned back RICO ACT for the win. RICO ACT tracked the winner along the rail, two path on the turn, eased out, gained to challenge between leaving the eighth pole and finished gamely. BULLDOG ON A BONE checked at the start, lagged back along the two path, entered the lane three from the fence angled the widest and closed fast. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE was unhurried two from the rail, entered the lane along the three path, angled wide and closed fast. NEWTON CRESCENT tracked the winner along the three path, moved to challenge some three across leaving the furlong marker and then weakened. BLACK ACE never far back along the four path on the turn, five wide into the lane and weakened. CURRENT AQUASITION was well placed tracking along the three path on the turn, angled out four wide into the lane and tired. THE BUTLER DID IT saved ground and tired.
