**Footnotes**

WILLIAM THOMAS was unhurried along the rail, gained inside on the turn, angled out in the stretch, rallied under the whip to take the lead and drew off. PASSING TIME stalked the leaders along the two path on the turn, three path into the lane, responded to pressure and earned the place. FRIED was unhurried early, two path on the turn, eased out and rallied while finishing between rivals on the line. NEW YORK TOUGH vied for the lead along the three path up the backstretch, three path into the lane, battled to no avail and then weakened late. UP IN SMOKE was unhurried four wide up the backstretch, saved ground on the corner and tired. EXLEY vied for the lead along the rail to midstretch and gave way.
