LOWER EASTSIDE was well placed along the rail, eased out into the lane, responded and bested CAMERON CANYON for the win. CAMERON CANYON was well placed five wide on the turn, moved to take the lead and then finished gamely. RIVER MONSTER was unhurried four wide on the turn, responded outside and finished with interest. MR. HOLLYWOOD was unhurried removed from the rail, responded some inside and finished with interest. SIR HOLLISTER lagged back six wide on the turn and then finished wide. HOTCHOI tracked four wide on the turn and tired. PUT IT IN THE SKY lagged back five wide on the turn, was not a factor. BALTIC COAST saved ground and tired. HARRIER HILL assumed the lead, set the pace along the three path and gave way.
