GREAT QUEST was three deep near the pace, lodged his bid nearing the far turn then drew clear through the stretch. SAND CANYON vied for the lead, responded when challenged nearing the stretch then was no match for the winner but held the place. CHOP HOUSE vied for the lead from between foes, remained a threat into the stretch but didn't have enough late. PROPHET'S TOWN rated off the leaders, was five wide into the stretch then lacked a solid bid. FLAG TO FLY broke awkwardly then was rank after the start, was six wide into the stretch and never seriously threatened. CODE AMOUR was seven wide around the first turn, moved into contention down the backstretch then lacked a further response. ALEDOLYTE had brief speed after the start into the first turn, took the rail down the backstretch then lacked a stretch response.
