Footnotes

STORM TREE pressed the pace, split horses to head leader, gained lead at top of stretch and drew off from field. CROW CHIEF stalked the pace, made a middle move but no match for the winner. THE COUNTRYS BEST set the early pace, weakened when put under pressure entering the stretch and gave way. FLAMING JAWS stalked the pace, offered a mild bid racing inside but failed to menace. CLOG lacked a late response. MOUNTAIN GULCH showed little. ECONOMIC CONCERN was unhurried early, no factor. P L RIVER PRO broke awkwardly, lost all chance. TURN IT ON FIVE rushed to contention, raced outside three wide and was through after the half. SAUNA BOY stalked the pace, failed to respond.
