ETJET was allowed to settle, angled to inside saving ground, had a mild bid to no avail. RARE OKIE was void of early speed, showed little. BOBBY BE GOLD pressed the pace racing inside, through after the half. WASABI no factor. WITH AUTHORITY failed to menace.
