FOXIE AN FUN stalked the pace while racing along the rail, offered a late rally but was no match for the winner. GRIS LIGHTNING was unhurried early, closed late with a mild bid and a good effort. KINSLEE A chased the leader for the first half, lost ground and dropped back. NOTABLE THRILL stalked the pace but lacked a late response. MISS DUSTY ROSE stalked the pace and failed to menace. P L RIVER OAK was even throughout and never a factor. WANN A LIGHT raced four wide, was through after the half. DIAMOND SMOKE dull effort, raced green and was outrun. CHIEF ME NOW was void of early speed, trailed and outrun.
