MISS DAISY DO was rushed to contention and gained lead after pressing the pace for two furlongs, kept to task for the win. CROW CHIEF stalked the pace, closed outside then threaded horses for racing room on the inside and was gamely outfinished. SLEWSAM was allowed to settle, made a middle move then weakened. RISEN GOLD was void of early speed, made a steady advance, but failed to menace. THE COUNTRYS BEST showed good early speed but was through after the half. ONE BUD TO GO showed little. CHASIN THE GIRLS was away alertly, set the pace, was through early. EL COLE never a factor. HUBBIN' IT failed to respond, raced greenly. EL RELANPAGO dull effort, bolted at the gap and lost jockey, raced green.
