R NANEES chased the early pace inside, made a bid entering the second turn but was no match while clearly second best. BOW TIME well placed inside, was no threat late while holding position. WINTER CAMEO could only pass tired ones. NAKIEWAH was no threat. STARSHIP DILIGENCE was no factor. RUNNIN AARONS had a steady fade.
