DYNAMICHAEL was rushed to contention and dueled with rival and prevailed at the wire. MERRY MAX was rushed to contention and dueled, tired and was gamely outfinished. MARK THE CAT stalked the pace racing inside, failed to menace. BIG CASH DEAL raced in the middle of the field, offered a mild bid but was no factor. TALKIE TALK TRIBE was unhurried early, made a middle move but no threat. OKIE RED OAK stalked the pace, lacked a late response. HOT LINK bobbed at the break, raced evenly with no rally and was outrun. LEADING MINER showed a dull effort, raced green and was outrun. STORM PASTUM rushed to contention, bolted in the first turn and was dq'd to last. KINSLEE A was carried out by rival in the first turn and had to be steadied, lost all chance.
