BARCARO stalked the pace racing three wide, wore down rival and gained the lead at the top of the lane racing full out. SPECIAL CAST set the pace the first half, tired under rival's challenge but still held on for the place. INDY BRASS slow to gather, closed fastest racing outside with a game effort. RED BEAU stalked the pace with a mild bid but failed to menace. RELEASE THE STORM was void of early speed, made a middle move but never a factor. WASHOPPER pressed the pace racing inside, through after the half. KORONA KAT raced in the middle of the field but lacked a late response. ITSY BITSY CAJUN showed little. MEGAWATT JOE was never a factor. RHYTHM GONE WEST had good early speed, raced along the rail, was through early.
